Discussion:

- **What is your imagination?**
 - My magic eye
 - The place where I see pictures and stories in my mind.
- **How do you use your imagination everyday?**
 - When I play pretend
 - When I create a story
- **What are some other ways to use your imagination?**
 - I can pick out my clothes to wear
 - I can think of the words to say
 - I can write or tell a story
 - I can solve a problem I'm having
 - I can think about what I'll be someday when I grow up

Activities:

- **Find a picture of someone, look in a book or magazine –**

- Characters - How many people or characters are in it?
 - Count them.
 - Give them names
- Setting - Where are they?
 - What do you see there?
 - Are they inside or outside?
 - What do you smell there?
 - Is there anything to taste there? Any food? What kind?
- Tell a story about what you see!
- What is the name/title of your story?

- **The Magic Circle**

Place a hula hoop on the floor or make a circle out of masking tape. Take turns sitting inside the circle and using your imagination. Once you are in the magic circle your mind will become magical.

- Ask: What can you see when you close their eyes? Are you somewhere in the world? Are you doing something fun? Who is with you?
- Ask them to describe what they see.
- Ask: Is your magic eye was really more magical in the circle or did it seem more magical because you were using your imagination?
- Remind them that their mind is always magical because their imagination is always inside their mind wherever they go.

- **Draw:**

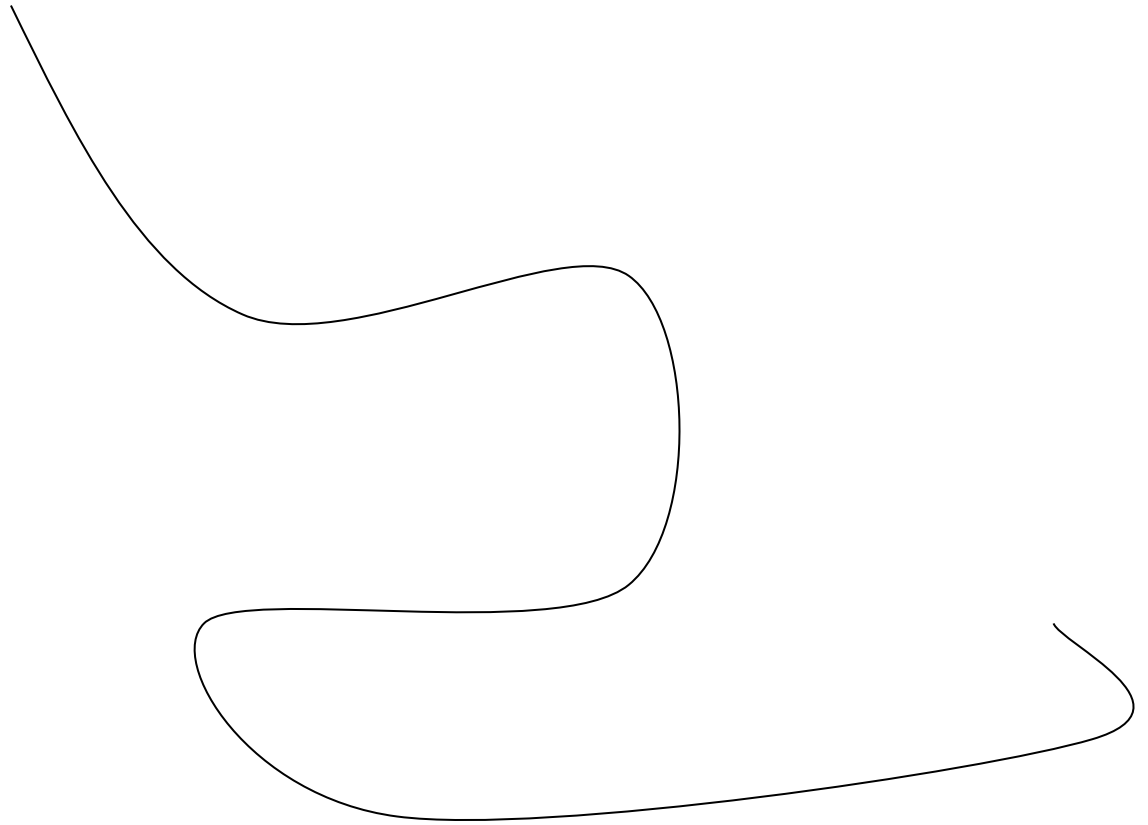
You can use your imagination to make something beautiful out of a scribble or even a mistake
